WATERING & WARRANTY INSTRUCTIONS



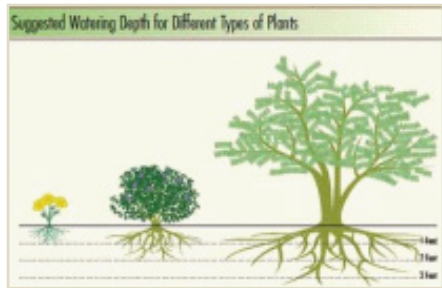

FOR NEWLY INSTALLED PLANTS

Newly planted trees and shrubs require special attention through the first two years. *A standard sprinkler system will not provide adequate water, making supplemental watering essential.*



Mountain High Tree Lawn & Landscape Co. will water in your new trees and shrubs on the day they are planted. Closely monitor your new plants for subsequent watering. At least every couple of weeks, check the moisture content in your soil by digging down several inches just *outside* of the root ball area. Disregard the first inch or two; if you find the soil too dry to form a ball when squeezed in your hand, you need to water your new plants. If the soil remains clumped and moist your hand, hold off on watering. If the soil crumbles, water thoroughly. *Deep watering is much better than several shallow waterings.*



Too much water deprives the root system of oxygen and can be just as harmful as not enough water.

Our different soil types, ranging from heavy clay soil to sandy soil, require different watering schedules. If you determine your new plants need water, thoroughly soak the top 10" to 12" of the entire root zone. With practice, you will learn to anticipate when your new trees and shrubs need water. *Mist the leaves or needles of your new trees and shrubs periodically. They will take in moisture, especially when hot and dry conditions exist.*

FOR WINTER CARE



Deciduous trees should be wrapped during the winter months (October thru the 1st of May) to help prevent sun scalding.

Don't forget to check soil moisture during the fall and winter months and water as needed. Winter dehydration is a major cause of a plant's decline and death. *Trees, shrubs and perennials must be watered monthly to prevent voiding the warranty.* [See the Plant Warranty Section for more information.]



Rather than frequent shallow waterings, you should thoroughly water monthly. Water during the day when temperatures are above 40 degrees to allow the water to soak in before freezing night temperatures set in.

A 2-3" layer of organic mulch spread over the root zone helps to keep the moisture level consistent, insulates against extreme temperatures, adds valuable organic material to the soil and conserves water. Make sure to keep the mulch off the tree trunk.



A general rule of thumb is to use approximately 10 gallons of water per inch of the trunks diameter for each watering. Measure the trunks diameter at knee height. General formula: Tree Diameter x 5 min. = Total Watering

PLANT WARRANTY

Planting Guarantee: One (1) year from the date of installation. Warranty shall be a one-time replacement that includes plant material and labor costs. Trees and shrubs must be properly watered.

Trees and shrubs can show some stress immediately following planting, but normally they will recover quickly. You should keep a close eye on your new plants for the first two years. At the first sign of something unusual with your new plant material, contact our arborists immediately regarding your concerns. Our Arborists can assist you with information to help keep your new plant material healthy. Under watering, over watering, insect infestation and lack of winter watering can all have adverse effects on a young plant. If caught early these problems can be evaluated and remedied. Waiting to call our arborists until after your plant is already dead can void your warranty.

If Mountain High Tree Lawn & Landscape Co. is providing a plant health care program including insect and disease control for your new plant material, plant failure resulting from insects or disease damage will be covered in your warranty.

Planting Guarantee for trees and shrubs does not cover: Storm damage, vandalism or neglect.
